## Course contents

<p>Description</p>	<p>This course is designed for teachers who would like to further their knowledge on the use of ICT in class and to experiment with <b>new enjoyable tools</b>. The course will focus on web solutions such as Edmodo, Google educational tools, online Quizzes, and others.</p> <p>During the course, participants will learn by doing: working in groups, they will have the opportunity to <b>test different tools directly</b>, and to share examples about how to use them in class.</p> <p>The techniques acquired in the course will enable teachers to make their lessons <b>more engaging</b> for their students, thus making them more effective.</p> <p>Upon the completion of the course, teachers will be aware of the strengths and weaknesses of many different ICT tools, and will know how to exploit them in the classroom in a safe and useful way.</p>
<p>Learning outcomes</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Use audiovisual platforms, making a search easier, creating playlists about different topics, sharing and embedding videos and playlists;</li><li>• Use online platforms for communication and sharing: managing a virtual classroom, sending assignments, searching and sharing useful materials, communicating with students and parents;</li><li>• Know Google Drive and Google Apps used as educational resources;</li><li>• Motivate students through serious digital games and online quizzes.</li></ul>
